As announced by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC), 565 out of 1,024 (55.18%) passed the Librarian Licensure Examination given by the Board for Librarians. The PRC said that of the 565 passers, 482 are first takers and 83 are repeaters.

CC BLIS program got an overall performance rating of 50% passing rate.

Four BLIS 18 unit takers: Riza Bamba, Ma. Theresa Floresca, Jenny Tolentino, and Janice Lan Juban also passed the said exam.
